No admission to the Fairgrounds will be charged to contestants over 18 years of age - just explain that you are a contestant in the pageant. **Admission to the fairgrounds is \$15 for an adult. Those who are 18 years of age and under are admitted free when accompanied by an adult.**

Awards: **One winner in each age division.** The total highest score combining beauty and casual wear will be the winner. Winners will receive a Polish Heritage trophy, crown, banner, and gift. Winners will be hostesses for the two remaining days of the Festival. **There will be four runners-up in each age division.** All runners-up will receive a Polish Heritage trophy and gift.
